

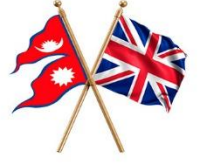

NRNA UK condemns attack on Gurkha veteran

The Non Resident Nepali Association (NRNA) UK has been deeply concerned by the attack on elderly former Gurkha soldier at the Municipal Gardens in Aldershot.

Such a despicable act targeting the Nepali community is unacceptable under any circumstances. We condemn such incidents in the strongest terms.

The mistreatment of former Gurkhas, who have made a brave and glorious identity in world history, on the basis of skin colour and origin, has shocked the entire Nepali community in the UK. We demand that the perpetrators be brought to justice immediately.

We also appeal to all Nepalis in the UK to remain vigilant and united against such incidents that spread hatred and divide society. We would also like to inform that NRNA UK is coordinating with local administrations and legal bodies to prevent an atmosphere of fear in the community and to ensure the safety of Nepalis.

In the wake of the recent violent incidents in Northern Ireland and various provocative activities targeting immigrants, we urge everyone to exercise restraint. We also express our commitment that NRNA UK will always be at the forefront to ensure justice and protection of Nepalis and citizens of Nepali origin living in the UK.
